County Hosts Household Hazardous Waste Collections

WAYNE COUNTY, MI – Wayne County's Department of Environment is hosting two Household Hazardous Waste Collections for County residents. The collections are designed to accept unwanted household chemicals for proper disposal and electronics (i.e. computer monitors, printers, scanners, keyboards, cell phones, fax machines, and TVs) for recycling from residents.

The collections are scheduled for **Saturday, June 27, 2009 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.** at Northville Public Works, 650 Doheny, just north of 7 Mile Road and East of South Main Street, and **Saturday, August 22, 2009 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** at the Westland Shopping Center, Warren Road and Nankin Boulevard. All HHW items will be accepted at no cost from Wayne County residents only.

Items that will be accepted include household paints, stains, floor care items, furniture polish, bathroom cleaners, lawn and garden chemicals, antifreeze, fluorescent and compact fluorescent light bulbs, old computers and TVs. Pharmaceutical waste (non-controlled substances only) and medical sharps will also be accepted. All waste must be from residential sources.
