Re: City Administrator's Report to Council

1. Allen Road remains closed at the Ecorse Creek while Wayne County rebuilds the bridge. It appears that there will be two lanes opening to traffic just around Thanksgiving. The project will be completely finished with restoration in early 2021.

2. Street Improvement Millage (GV Cement):

Meyer Avenue – The last items left on Meyer Avenue are ADA ramps, some concrete work by Voran's, and restoration of the easements. The intersection of Meyer and Quandt will open tomorrow. At that point, the entire street will be open.

- 3. DPS Facility Project:
  - Good weather has helped to make progress on the building.
  - GV finished pouring the remaining road necessary to erect the salt dome.
    The concrete blocks for the salt dome were delivered today and the structure arrives at the end of the week. GV's sub-contractor, Bore
    Brothers is scheduled to start boring the water and sewer lines on Friday.
  - Wolverine Steel is finishing the insulation and roof on the building. The roof should be completed by the middle of next week. Side framing will start once the masons get 8 feet of block up around the building.

- 4. The safety tiles were installed this past weekend at Briar Rabbit Park. Some additional equipment and restoration are still needed before the project is complete.
