Re: City Administrator's Report to Council

1. Rosedale Boulevard Reconstruction Project: Hardrock Concrete is finishing approaches, sidewalks, and restoration between Champaign Road to Southfield Road. They have also started to remove Garfield Avenue from Rosedale Boulevard to the Lincoln Park border, as well as Regina Avenue from Rosedale Boulevard to the Lincoln Park border, and plan on pouring that during the first part of next week (weather permitting). Rosedale Boulevard will continue to be CLOSED at Southfield Road a short time longer for the safety of the workers.
2. Reeck Road Water Main Replacement and Reconstruction Project: Reeck Road is closed between Goddard Road and Midway Avenue. The contractor is awaiting test results so they can begin hooking up the new permanent water services from Goddard Road to Promenade Avenue. Next week, the contractor will begin boring under the creek at Midway Avenue and Promenade Avenue. They will also begin to move the temporary water main to prepare for the next segment of pipe bursting.
3. Paris Avenue Reconstruction Project: Savone Cement has started to remove the north side of Paris Avenue. Approaches and sidewalks on the south side of Paris Avenue are complete. Sod for the restoration will be installed after Labor Day.

4. Concrete Sectioning Program: Savone Cement has continued street sectioning on Meyer Avenue and Dasher Avenue between Allen Road and Roger Avenue.
5. Joint Sealing Program: Al's Asphalt will begin in August on Ecorse Road between Pelham Road and Roosevelt. Once Ecorse Road is complete, they will be working in the area west of Allen Road to Arno Avenue from Beatrice Avenue to Hanfor Avenue.
6. Sergeant Shaun Harvey and Officer Pat Moore will be attending the 2023 Michigan Association of Hostage Negotiation (MAHN) Conference that will be held in October in Traverse City.
7. The following employee will reach a milestone in years of service with the City –
 - Shaun Harvey (Police Department) – 15 Years – July 21st
