Re: City Administrator's Report to Council

1. Rosedale Boulevard Reconstruction Project: Hardrock Concrete has been joint sealing Rosedale Boulevard yesterday and today. They will be sweeping and finishing some various clean-up areas on Wednesday and Thursday. Rosedale Boulevard is set to re-open sometime on Friday. There may be some remaining small construction work taking place in certain areas, but the road will be open during this time.
2. Reeck Road Water Main Replacement and Reconstruction Project: Reeck Road is closed between Goddard Road and Maylawn Avenue. The contractor is now working north of the creek to Maylawn – preparing section 2 for pipe bursting.
3. Paris Avenue Reconstruction Project: Weather permitting, Savone Cement will finish pouring the north side of Paris Avenue. Approaches and sidewalks on the north side of Paris Avenue will begin next week. The street is scheduled to be opened by Friday, August 4th, weather permitting.
4. Concrete Sectioning Program: Savone Cement has continued street sectioning on Meyer Avenue and Dasher Avenue between Allen Road and Roger Avenue. They will be moving this week to do concrete repairs by Arno School. After the school area is completed, they will move to several streets off Ecorse Road.

5. Joint Sealing Program: Al's Asphalt will begin in August on Ecorse Road between Pelham Road and Roosevelt. Once Ecorse Road is complete, they will be working in the area west of Allen Road to Arno Avenue from Beatrice Avenue to Hanfor Avenue.
6. School Resource Officer Jared Knudsen will be attending the Basic SRO Training offered by the National Association of School Resource Officers (NASRO) that will be held in August in Grand Blanc.
7. Gail McFarland, Police Records Bureau, will be attending the 2023 Law Enforcement Records Management Association (LERMA) Fall Training Conference that will be held in September in Traverse City.
8. The kickoff event for the grant that the City received from America In Bloom and CN Rail to build/improve the Brand Park Vietnam Veterans & Beyond Memorial and the Champaign Park Blue Star Memorial will be held on Monday, August 7th at 11:00 AM at the Champaign Park pavilion.
