**Re: City Administrator's Report to Council**

1. Allen Road is now open at the Ecorse Creek, as Wayne County has completed the bridge replacement project.
2. Wayne County will be re-building the Moran Avenue Bridge over the Sexton and Kilfoil Drain (near Goddard & Old Goddard). Moran Avenue will close on June 6<sup>th</sup> and the expected project completion is November 5<sup>th</sup>.
3. Wayne County has started the traffic signal modernization project at the intersection of Ecorse Road and Pelham Road. Work will include new signage, pavement markings, and a Left Turn signal. The project is expected to be completed this summer and final restoration by the fall.
4. The Belmont Avenue water main replacement project from Fox Avenue to Champaign Road has had 95% the concrete replaced. The easement areas have been graded and are just waiting for the sod to be placed.
5. Street Improvement Millage: The Contractor (GV Cement) will start on June 1<sup>st</sup> to remove the old asphalt and concrete on Park Avenue. The project area is Regina Avenue to Angelique Avenue.
6. Street Sectioning: The Contractor (Savone Cement) is currently working on Philomene Boulevard between Fox Avenue and Rosedale Boulevard and between Rosedale Boulevard and the Lincoln Park border. They will starting on Quandt Avenue between Dasher Avenue and Southfield Road in early June.
7. Al's Asphalt will be in the City to start their list of projects on June 1<sup>st</sup>, starting with the Police Impound Lot (part of the DPS Facility project), and moving to the Cunningham Park parking lot, the Community Center parking lot, Beatrice Avenue, the DDA alleys, and the road to the old DPS Mechanic's Garage.
8. The Allen Park Fire Department is offering In-Home Covid-19 Vaccinations (one dose Johnson & Johnson) for home-bound Allen Park residents through May 27<sup>th</sup>.
9. The Festivities Commission is planning the 2021 Allen Park Street Fair for Friday, August 6<sup>th</sup>, and Saturday, August 7<sup>th</sup>. The hours for both days will be 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM. There will be no beer, wine, or entertainment, as they try to meet all of the Covid-19 mandates and keep social distancing in place.
