SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- University of Michigan epidemiologist, Arnold Monto, states that it is crucial to recognize that COVID-19 is "a very strange virus. Its origin, transmission, symptoms and damage remain puzzles. And its future seems to defy computer modeling. Because of that, experts start any conversation by warning that the first wave is still cresting and that predicting the future of the coronavirus is a fool's game."
- AstraZeneca has received more than \$1 billion from the U.S. Health Department's Biomedical Advanced Research and Development Authority (BARDA) to develop a COVID-19 vaccine from the University of Oxford.
- Governor Whitmer signed the following Executive Orders:
 - [2020-96](#): Reopens retail businesses and auto dealerships by appointment statewide on Tuesday, May 26, as part of her MI Safe Start plan. The governor's executive order also lifts the requirement that health care providers delay some nonessential medical, dental, and veterinary procedures statewide beginning on Friday, May 29. The order also authorizes small gatherings of 10 people or less starting immediately, as long as participants practice social distancing.
 - [2020-97](#): Updates Executive Order [2020-91](#) on workplace safety. Per the amended order, reopened outpatient health-care facilities, including clinics, primary care physician offices, and dental offices, will have to adopt strict protocols to prevent infection. The Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs will issue guidance to aid those facilities in adopting appropriate safeguards.
- The agency in charge of public transit in New York City announced a pilot program using ultraviolet light lamps to kill COVID-19 on buses, trains, and at stations. The Metropolitan Transportation Authority said that it will use "150 dual-headed mobile devices" from Denver-based start-up PURO Lighting to determine the efficiency and cost-effectiveness of the UVC light technology.
