SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- With positive COVID-19 cases ticking up, Governor Whitmer said she's not afraid to shut the state back down if the trend continues. She states: "I'm not going to be bullied into moving before it's safe. If we have to move back, we're going to. We've done an incredible amount of work, and I would hate to think that this sacrifice that we have made would be made in vain because some people are losing interest or are dropping their guard. We've got to double down right now more than ever."
- The National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID), part of the National Institutes of Health, has established a new clinical trials network that aims to enroll thousands of volunteers in large-scale clinical trials; testing a variety of investigational vaccines and monoclonal antibodies intended to protect people from COVID-19.
- Governor Whitmer signed executive order [2020-147](#), which reiterates that individuals are required to wear a face covering whenever they are in an indoor public space. It also requires the use of face coverings in crowded outdoor spaces. Most significantly, the order requires any business that is open to the public to refuse entry or service to people who refuse to wear a face covering, with limited exceptions.
- Officials are warning of fake mask exemption cards being sold online as a scam. Alma Galvan, with the Better Business Bureau, says the cards have been advertised online for about \$50. She states: "At first glance, it looks real. A supposed face mask exemption has a Department of Justice seal, a warning from the ADA and the promise of a fine for denying access to the non-mask wearer. The problem is, it's fake. We are alerting consumers to please don't give into this. Don't buy them online, you're exposing yourself to be a victim of identity theft."
- When performing autopsies on seven COVID-19 victims aged between 44-65 years, Dr. Amy Rapkiewicz, the Chairman of the Department of Pathology at NYU Langone Medical Center discovered that blood clotting was present in almost every organ, including the heart, kidneys and liver. Other findings in the [study](#) suggest that blood clotting plays a role very early in the disease process.
