## SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has reported that out-of-hospital deaths from March—May 2020 have increased by 62% compared to March—May 2019. MDHHS is urging the public to not delay emergency care during the pandemic.
- The Wayne County Public Health Division confirmed a total of 13 cases of COVID-19 are connected to the Playhouse Club in Romulus. Of these 13 cases, 12 are employees or patrons of the club and one confirmed case was an employee of a Checkers restaurant in Romulus.
- Millions of Americans marked a very different Independence Day this year, with many choosing virtual celebrations or canceling plans altogether amid mounting concern over the COVID-19 pandemic. However, many crowds across the country still gathered to celebrate while not social distancing or wearing masks. This leads to an anticipated increase in COVID-19 cases.
- Health experts have been warning of a possible second wave of COVID-19 for weeks. As confirmed cases exceed 11 million globally and new outbreaks surge across the US and around the world, some doctors and scientists say the second wave is already upon us. But others caution that this recent uptick isn't evidence of a second wave, that it's actually still part of the virus' first pass.
- An experimental COVID-19 vaccine being developed by the drug giant Pfizer and the biotech firm BioNTech spurred immune responses in healthy patients, but also caused fever and other side effects, especially at higher doses. The first clinical data on the vaccine were disclosed in a paper released on a preprint server, meaning it has not yet been peer-reviewed or published in a journal.
- Governor Whitmer signed Senate Bills 876-878, which codify her previous Executive Orders, further extending the renewal dates for driver's licenses, CDLs, state ID cards and vehicle registrations. Among the extensions outlined in the legislation, those with driver's licenses or vehicle registrations expiring after March 1 have until September 30, 2020 to have them renewed.
