## SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- The civilian member of the Detroit Police Department who died Monday, 03/23/2020, was a 38 year-old male working as an Emergency Services Deployment Operator. He did not have any underlying medical conditions that doctors were aware of and passed away before receiving results confirming that he had COVID-19.
- MDHHS lab in conjunction with other commercial labs are running approximately 1,000 COVID-19 tests/day.
- Businesses violating Executive Order 2020-21 could be charged with a misdemeanor.
- Michigan Attorney General Dana Nessel has sent a Cease and Desist letter to two (2) businesses in Rockford, MI that have been falsely marketing a "Coronavirus Defender Patch" where they claim it will protect people from contracting COVID-19.

- The Attorney General's Office has received approximately 1,600 price-gouging filing complaints related to COVID-19. As a result, a team of special agents has been assigned to assist the attorneys in gathering information.
