## SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- In the wake of reopenings taking place across the country, more than 20 states are reporting steady increases in new COVID-19 cases on a daily basis, according to data collected by Johns Hopkins University. Dr. Anthony Fauci reportedly told U.S. Congress officials that he believes that trend could double later this summer.
- A COVID-19 antibody cocktail (REGN-COV2) for treatment and prevention of COVID-19, is in its Phase 3 clinical trial by the biotech company Regeneron. The Phase 3 trial is expected to include 2,000 patients and it will test the drug's ability to prevent infection if you have had close contact to an infected person, such as a household member. Regeneron has been awarded a \$450 million (USD) contract to manufacture and supply REGN-COV2 as part of "Operation Warp Speed," the federal government's COVID-19 vaccine program.
- Governor Whitmer signed Executive Order [2020-145](#) which outlines workplace safety guidelines for meatpacking plants to keep employees safe.
- Governor Whitmer signed Executive Order [2020-146](#) which extends protections for vulnerable populations in Michigan's county jails, local lockups and juvenile detention centers through Aug. 6, 2020.
- Governor Whitmer signed Executive Directive [2020-7](#) which directs the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) to begin developing rules that will require implicit bias training as part of the knowledge and skills necessary for licensure, registration and renewal of licenses and registrations of health professionals in Michigan.
- The Michigan National Guard will continue its partnership with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, the Michigan State Police State Emergency Operations Center, and local health departments to offer drive-thru COVID-19 testing this week in Flint and Allegan.
- State Treasurer Rachael Eubanks announced two new grant programs that will provide an overall total of \$300 million to help first responders receive premium hazard pay and reimburse local governments for payroll costs incurred due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
