SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- A team of researchers led by Dr. Laura Lamb and Dr. Michael Chancellor at the Aikens Research Center at Beaumont Research Institute have developed a new, highly accurate COVID-19 test that would detect the virus in urine, blood, saliva or a mouth-swab in 30-45 minutes. The new testing method could be used for screening at places like nursing homes, long-term care facilities, cruise ships, school systems and more.
- Governor Whitmer signed Executive Order [2020-143](#) closing indoor service at bars throughout most of lower Michigan to protect the progress Michigan has made against COVID-19.
- Governor Whitmer signed Senate Bill 690, which appropriates nearly \$880 million in federal funding to support various COVID-19 response actions across the state. The supplemental budget includes a number of provisions that assist Michigan in responding to the COVID-19 pandemic, help small business weather the difficult economic conditions created by COVID-19, and ensure that workers who put themselves at risk on the frontlines are fairly compensated.
- Governor Whitmer also signed Senate Bills 876-878, which codify her previous Executive Orders and further extend the renewal dates for driver's licenses, CDLs, state ID cards and vehicle registrations. Among the extensions outlined in the legislation, those with driver's licenses or vehicle registrations expiring between Feb. 1 and June 30 would have until Sept. 30, 2020 to have them renewed.
- Medical experts say even the mildly symptomatic COVID-19 survivors can struggle with serious long-term effects that can linger for weeks, even months after they were diagnosed. Possibilities include:
 - They may have a complication of the virus or a secondary infection.
 - The virus is still in the body somewhere, but not detectable with current testing.
 - Post-Viral Inflammatory Syndrome that might have damaged the autonomic nervous system affecting heart rate, blood pressure, digestion, and sleep.
- Sarah Gilbert, Professor of Vaccinology at the University of Oxford, and one of the scientists leading its vaccine initiative stated that eight thousand people in the UK have been vaccinated so far as part of the Oxford University vaccine trial that is now in phase three.
