SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- The Dearborn Schools Board of Education voted to [extend](#) online learning in the district for another month. The next Board meeting is now scheduled for Oct. 26. At that meeting they plan to “reevaluate conditions and agreed to continue and expand the in-school learning labs that launched districtwide last week,” reads a statement from the district.

- [Facebook](#) will start banning advertisements that discourage people from getting vaccinated, the social media company said, as it also announced a new flu vaccine information campaign. The United States-based company said in a blog post on October 13 that ads advocating for or against legislation or government policies around vaccines, including a COVID-19 vaccine, would still be allowed. **Source: Aljazeera**
- The Takeda Pharmaceutical Co-led group that is developing a [blood plasma treatment](#) for COVID-19 has started manufacturing while the late-stage trial to determine whether it works is ongoing. The alliance is testing a hyperimmune globulin therapy, which is derived from blood plasma of people who have recovered from COVID-19. Hyperimmune globulin therapy offers a standardized dose of antibodies and does not need to be limited to patients with matching blood types, which makes it more advanced and convenient than treatment with convalescent plasma drawn from recovered patients. **Source: Reuters**
