SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Meijer stores have started vaccinating people at a few of its pharmacies in Wayne County. Michigan state officials picked the supercenter chain as a vaccination partner to help meet its goal of giving 50,000 shots every day. Meijer is qualified as what the federal government calls a federal retail pharmacy. The state provides the vaccine on a weekly basis and Meijer is currently having vaccination clinics in Taylor, Westland, Livonia and Allen Park. The current focus is those who are 65-years-old and older.—**Click on Detroit**
- MDHHS released an [epidemic order](#), which continues the department's fact-based approach to reopening activities, and goes into effect on Monday, Feb. 1. The order will allow for indoor dining at restaurants with certain requirements; concessions at casinos, movie theaters and stadiums; personal services requiring mask removal; and non-residential gatherings of up to 10 people from two households. The new order will last three weeks, until Sunday, Feb. 21.—**Michigan.gov**
- Speaker Nancy Pelosi said Thursday (Jan. 21) that House Democrats will move immediately on a massive coronavirus relief package, setting the stage for an early showdown in the newly flipped Senate over the chief legislative priority of the nascent Biden administration. "We're getting ready for a COVID relief package. We'll be working on that as we go," she stated. "We'll be doing our ... committee work all next week so that we are completely ready to go to the floor when we come back."—**The Hill**
- President Joe Biden has signed two executive orders on Friday (Jan. 22) to address the economic toll of the coronavirus pandemic, including expanding food stamps and beginning the process to require that everyone working for the federal government get a minimum wage of \$15 an hour.—**NBC News**
