SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Marc Lipsitch, an epidemiology professor at Harvard's School of Public Health and director of the Center for Communicable Disease Dynamics expressed concerns of businesses reopening too soon amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. He states: "Almost every government is talking about lifting control measures. Not every government, but many, because of the economic burdens. Given the fairly high caseloads that we have in the United States, that's a really risky thing to do right now."
- Governor Whitmer signed Executive Order [2020-78](#) to temporarily extend the expiration of state identification cards, driver's licenses and operator endorsements through 07/31/2020. It also suspends penalties for vehicle registration violations, and protects Michigan drivers.
- On Friday, Michigan leaders encouraged those without residential water service due to nonpayment to reach out to local water departments for reconnection. All occupied homes without water are entitled to have service reconnected by local water departments based Executive Order [2020-28](#).
- The State of Michigan has approved contracts to rapidly expand Michigan's contact tracing efforts, a critical next step in its COVID-19 response. More than 3,500 [volunteers](#) have completed contact tracing training and are ready to begin aiding local health departments. This workforce will help speed up the process and provide support to local health departments already conducting contact tracing statewide.
- The Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development and the Michigan Economic Development Corporation want the state's food and agriculture companies to know they are now eligible for the U.S. Small Business Administration's Economic Injury Disaster Loan and EIDL Advance programs. Qualified Michigan food and agriculture businesses that have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, and have fewer than 500 employees, are encouraged to prepare their business financial information and [apply](#).
- Milken Institute, an independent research institute based in California, has developed a [tracker](#) for COVID-19 treatments being considered and vaccines in development. Dates and times of the latest updates are included on the tracker.
