SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Researchers worldwide are working around the clock to find a vaccine against SARS-CoV-2, the virus causing the COVID-19 pandemic. Regulatory Affairs Professionals Society (RAPS), a global organization involved with regulation of healthcare and related products has provided a [tracker list](#) of COVID-19 vaccine candidates. This tracker includes candidates are currently in Phase 1-3 trials, as well as major candidates in pre-clinical stages of development and research. Information will be updated weekly.
- As some states see declining COVID-19 cases and gradually reopen, infectious disease experts warn that a second wave of COVID-19 is inevitable, though the extent of the resurgence remains unclear. "I think people mistake the idea of society reopening with the idea that society is safer, but things are no safer today than they were weeks ago when we were in full lockdown," said Dr. Lawrence Kleinman, MD MPH of Rutgers University.
- Governor Whitmer signed Executive Orders [2020-118](#), which further extends the duration of protections for tenants and mobile home owners from being evicted from their home until June 30, and Executive Order and [2020-119](#), which extends protections for vulnerable populations in Michigan's county jails, local lockups and juvenile detention centers until July 9.
- Working in partnership with nine local economic development organizations, the Michigan Economic Development Corporation has awarded \$4.35 million to 74 small businesses in 40 counties across Michigan in the first round of low-interest loans awarded through the [Michigan Small Business Relief Program](#), MEDC announced today. Today's support builds on \$10 million in grants awarded to more than 2,700 businesses through the program last month.
- A new report released by the Imperial College COVID-19 Response Team shows that the aggressive actions Governor Whitmer took to protect Michigan families from the spread of COVID-19 have significantly lowered the number of cases and deaths that would have occurred had the state done nothing. The data shows that very few states dropped their infection rate as low for as long as Michigan.
- Eastern Michigan University has announced a safety initiative for the Fall semester by offering students who choose to live on campus the option of a single room. Those who wish to have a roommate can still continue to do so.
